## Organising and Synthesising Literature

Uses: organizing and synthesising the content of the literature you have identified in your research, in order to write a literature review, essay, report, or oral presentation.

- 1. Read the literature you have identified through your research and extract the main themes
- 2. List the themes in the first column (the number of themes will depend on your research)
- 3. Write the citations of each of your sources in the first row (the number of sources will depend on your research)
- 4. Make notes in each cell of the table as to what each article states about the theme (It is not necessary that all articles will address each theme)
- 5. Note flaws or limitations of each article in the final row.
