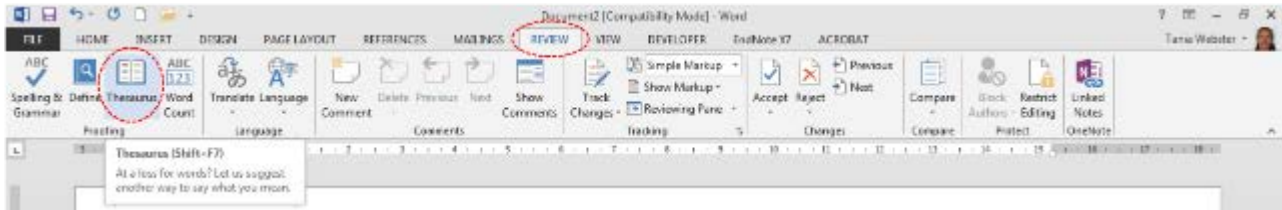


Thesaurus

The thesaurus enables you to look up synonyms (these are different words with the same meaning), and antonyms are words with the opposite meaning.

Click on the **Review** tab in the **Proofing** group << **Thesaurus**



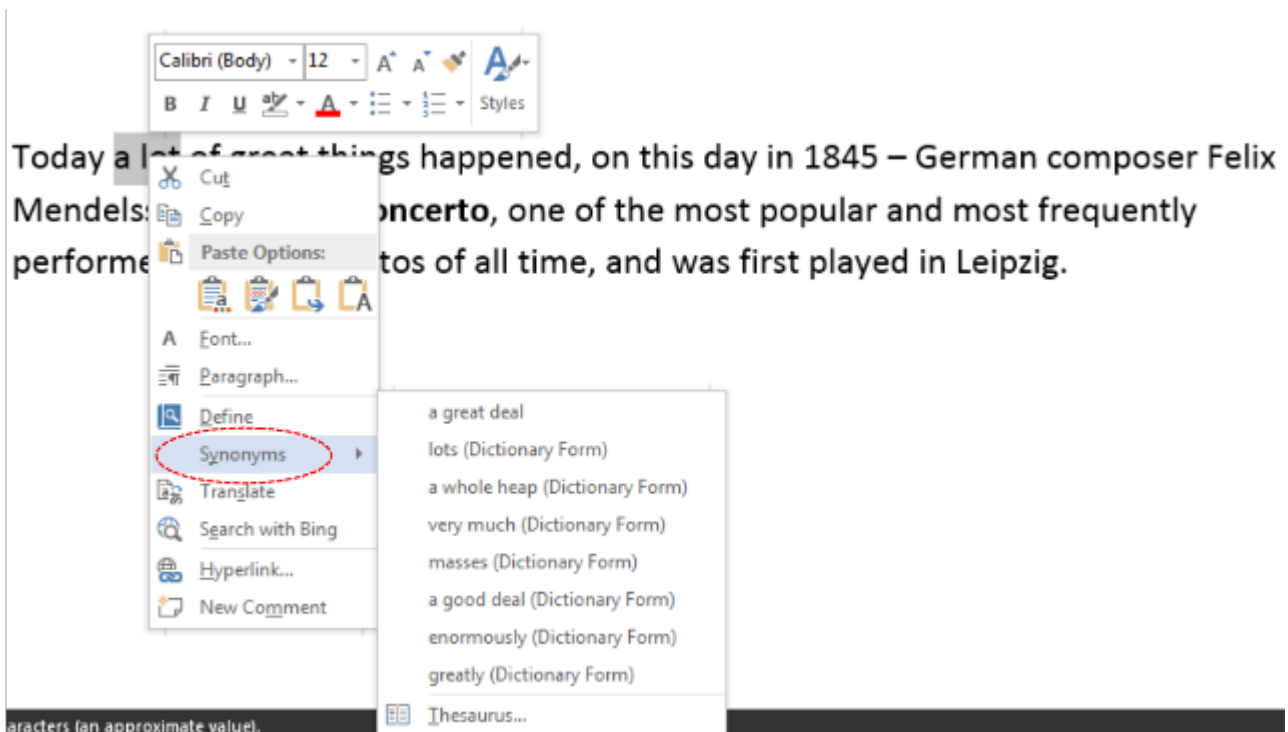
Example using the Thesaurus

To change the sentence below, I chose the words **a lot** to something more appropriate;

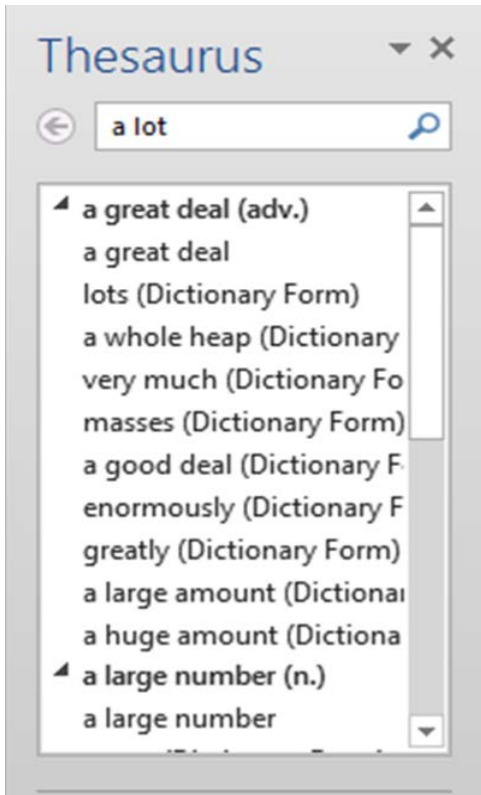

Right click on the word and the following box will appear << **Select** a word.



Select **Thesaurus** at the **bottom** of the **box** << a **list of words** will appear to the **right** of your screen.



To **insert** the **new wording** you want to use << **Click** on **down arrow** << **Choose Insert** and the new wording will be inserted over the original word.
