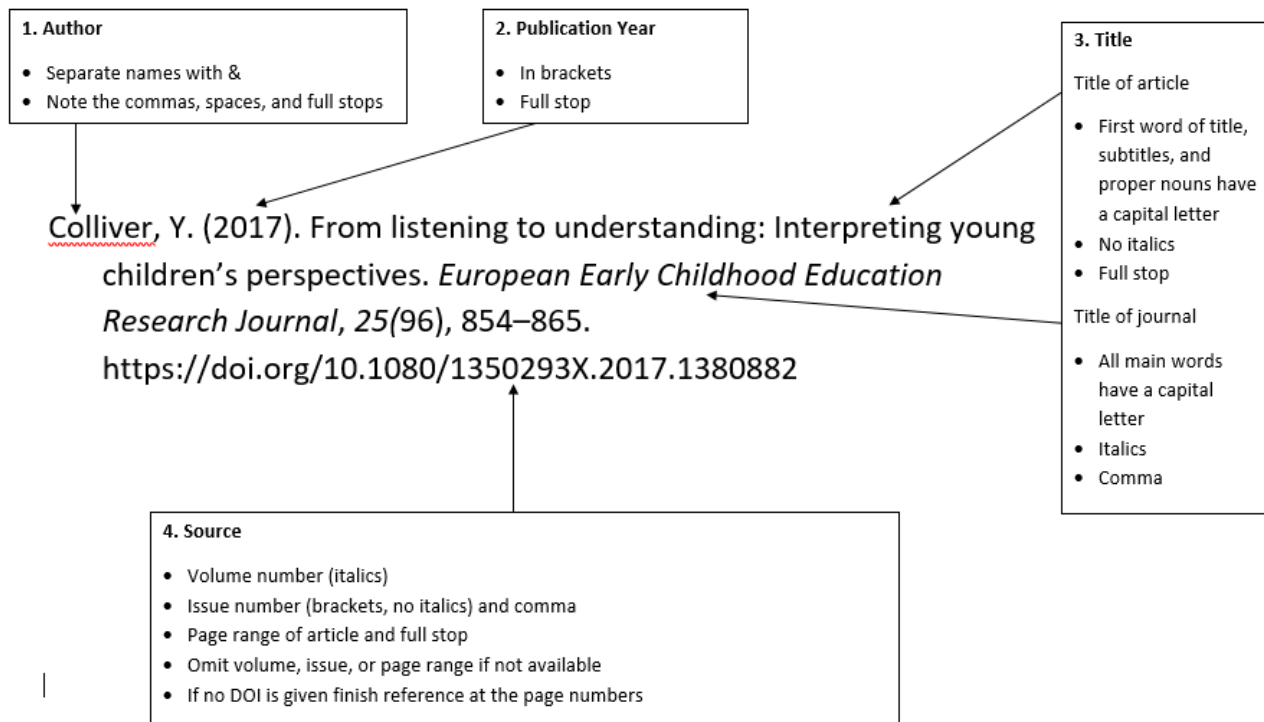


APA Referencing: How do I Reference a Journal Article?

What information do I need to create a reference for a journal article?

Elements that may be required to create a reference for a journal article are as follows:

1. Author	Author(s) Corporate or group author No author
2. Date	Year No date (n.d.)
3. Title	Title of article, and title of journal in italics
4. Source information	Volume number Issue number Page number(s) or article number(s) Use a DOI (if available), or URL Omit any missing information, e.g., issue number
