



Formatting the Reference List

The References page ...

- records a complete list of all sources you have cited in your assignment
- must be in APA 7th edition formatting
- sits at the end of the assignment and before any appendices
- is headed with the word **References** centred and in bold
- has page numbering that continues from the assignment (page numbering should be at the top right side in the header space of the page)
- is double spaced
- does not have additional line spacing between references
- is in the same font and point size as the rest of the assignment

References should ...

- follow the [APA 7th edition formatting](#)
- be presented in hanging indent: the first line of each reference is left aligned while all other lines are indented
- be in alphabetical order (use the A to Z sort function) 
- not contain superscripted characters. Reformat these using the superscript function (e.g., not 7th, but 7th) 
- have all URLs and DOIs starting with https://
- have all URLs and DOIs hyperlinked
