
Māori Language Keyboard and Macrons


In order to add macrons to letters when typing in Te Reo Māori, you need to adjust your language settings by adding the language or keyboard.

Language

Click the Apple icon in the top left-hand corner. Then click System Preferences.



Click on Language & Region.

Then, go to the toolbar at the top of the screen. The **Flag Icon** should be displaying the Māori Flag, as opposed to the Australian one.



If it is not, **Click** on the flag and **select** Māori from the dropdown menu.

Applying Macrons

To apply a macron, hit the Alt/Options key and then the letter you want to place a macron over. e.g. Alt + a will result in \bar{a} .
