1. Analyse the Essay Task

To address an essay task, first analyse the task requirements then plan the essay based on the task outline and the marking rubric. Emphasis on each point may be guided by the mark allocation.

	Identify the subject: What is the topic?		
	Identify the instruction: What do I have to do with the topic? Check for other significant words: Is there anything else I should be aware of?

	Introduction: Introduce the topic. Outline the points to be addressed and how they will be addressed (the verb) Main points: The number of main points will depend on the essay task and the content of your sources		Word count (approximately) 10%
