Qualifications for Bachelor Graduates

Graduate Certificate (level 6 and 7)

A person with a graduate certificate is able to

- demonstrate some outcomes of a bachelor's degree in a new area of study
- develop educational, professional, or vocational knowledge to broaden or deepen skills or knowledge already gained in an undergraduate degree

Graduate Diploma (level 6 and 7)

A person with a graduate diploma is able to

- demonstrate the outcomes of a bachelor's degree in a new area of study
- prepare to study a postgraduate diploma or master qualification

Postgraduate Diploma (level 8)

A graduate of a postgraduate diploma is able to

- show evidence of advanced knowledge in a specialist field of enquiry or professional practice and engage in rigorous intellectual analysis, criticism, and problem solving
- build on principal subject(s) of the qualifying degree, graduate diploma, or graduate certificate
- prepare for independent research and scholarship



Master Degree (level 8 and 9)

A graduate of a master degree is able to

- show evidence of advanced knowledge about a specialist field of enquiry or professional practice
- demonstrate mastery of sophisticated theoretical subject matter
- critically evaluate the findings and discussions in literature
- research, analyse, and argue from evidence
- work independently and apply knowledge to new situations
- engage in rigorous intellectual analysis, criticism, and problem solving
