AI can ...

- be used as an assistant and coach
- summarise, translate, and simplify information
- polish your grammar

**Your use of AI must be according to
the EIT Policy**

However ...

- AI information input range is not transparent.
- AI gives you one answer which encourages acceptance, but it may not be correct
- Applying information without your critical thinking has high risks. You are responsible for the AI generated output that you use: you can't blame AI if the information is incorrect or incomplete.

**Validate all AI outputs so you can
use the information with
confidence**

Therefore...

- AI is a very useful tool in the management of time and tasks
- It can unpack and simplify tasks to aid understanding
- It is masterful at re-bundling information



However ...

- Beware of cognitive outsourcing
- Do your due diligence by finding information from a number of reputable sources
